Indian agent at or before the time above specified and accompanied by a certified check on some National bank for not less than 10 per cent. of the gross amount of the bid; said checks to be payable to the order of the U. S. Indian agent.

The cattle will be closely herded for inspection of bidders, for at least five days previous to the day of sale.

Terms of sale—Cash before delivery; cattle to be removed within 10 days after notice of the acceptance of bid.

Any and all bids to be rejected if deemed for the best interest of the government, and sale to be ratified by the honorable secretary of the interior.
