The actual composition of manure will vary depending on the class of livestock, feed ration, amount of bedding used and age of the animal.


Values given on this side are averages provided by the University of Michigan.

Manure also contains other essential plant-food nutrients such as boron, calcium, copper, iron, magnesium, manganese, molybdenum, sulphur and zinc.

The value of manure as a soil conditioner, and source of organic matter is important, too. Some researchers put this "secondary" value equal to the value in major fertilizer elements.

Note (a): Tons to be hauled are calculated at about one half of total produced to allow for manure dropped on pasture. If animals are confined year-around on concrete, number of loads would be approximately double the number shown. Value calculations are also based on amount to be hauled, or approximately one-half of total produced.

Note (b): Value is calculated at the equivalent of one hundred pounds of 10-5-10 per ton of manure, for dairy and beef cattle, or \$2.50 per ton.
