Because of the crowded schedule, so far from home, I was compelled to give you an October 22 date.

However I am wondering, and I think I can hold Bert Broad here to an afternoon, would you want a Saturday morning, October 6, appearance? That would mean the very opening of the tour. We would have to break away by 12 o'clock noon to return to Yakima, but it might be best to handle it that way and get it out of the road.

You will recall I told you I had an extensive mailing list for Ellensburg, and would send out these invitations. I would also provide you with 100 to 200 invitations for your use to send out to selected customers. Your circulars I suspect will be provided by other sources, the Spokane store probably.

Please let me know right away your decision on this matter, marking up the enclosed invitation in the blank space with the proper date and hours, also store name, so I can see the printing is attended to. I will have many things to attend to shortly and will not longer be able to delay these details or will be compelled to abandon the book tour to Ellensburg.
