Reese:--The first step was taken yesterday afternoon. Want to bring the heads to the plaster stage, on the four, want to repay for clay etc. You can work out with Max, he and Herb (Jenkins). I will put you on the line to Max.

Max: Budget was set up for a start at about \$1,000. Want to repay you back for what is done, by putting the heads in the hard plaster stage. Repair work of head and hands, just over \$1,000. Didn't get into the other things. Came toward the close of the board meeting. Bob presented it to them.

Procedure now, probably due for voucher for work done. Lists \$160 for clay and supplies; \$320 for sitters, \$140 travel; \$25 photos. Total of \$645.

Second stage will be repair work, plaster etc. Total is \$1,045. When work is done another \$400.
