I am in desperate need of some maps, and know of no better informed person than you with whom to communicate.

The maps needed:

1-Oregon, Wash and Idaho of the period, 1862-64, showing locations of the various posts and army installations during the Civil War period. I have much research on the posts etc. but no especial map.

2-Any maps of the Yakima country, from any period, 1852 through 1885, showing streams and Indian fishing ~~xxxxxxx~~ locations. These could include any the Indian agents made, military men etc. An example is one I have, 1856, The Yakima Indian Country, that shows the Selah fishery.

These latter would help me with place names of the region in which I have been working. The designation of fisheries would be especially helpful.

Should you have maps of this nature in your collection, which I know of the finest, please let me know 1: Map price or 2, photostat price together with statement this is from such and such a map in your collection.

Of if you do not have them, perhaps you know of a repository where they may be available.

I have had greatest admiration for your historical work and especially for your map knowledge. I would appreciate it very much if you could assist me in my humble way at researching, confident that you know more of these matters than many of our "professionals."

Additionally, the latter maps, if they pertain to the Yakima Indian Reservation during the Alburx period, should be helpful in a more complete study of that time I also have under way, so it should have an especial interest to you.
