

LIBRARY CARDS

NEW - Any resident of the unincorporated area of Yakima County or a resident of any of the contracting towns* may have a library card free. Residents of non-contracting towns within Yakima County (which pay no tax support to the Regional Library) are charged \$8.00 per year for a borrower's card. Identification giving current address is required. Children under 14 need a parent's signature.

LOST - If your library record is clear, you may have a new card for 10¢ (juvenile) or 25¢ (adult).

RENEWALS - Library cards are good for one year and may be renewed provided there are no overdue books or other library materials against your record.

LIBRARY PATRON RECORDS

A record is kept of your library card application, address changes, and any overdue library material. This information is confidential.

BOOK SECURITY SYSTEM

When library material which has not been properly checked out is carried through the detection area, the sensing equipment sets off an audible alarm and temporarily locks the gate. Materials are desensitized during the check-out process and resensitized before return to the library shelves. Once checked out, they can be carried back and forth through the detection area without activating the alarm.

CIRCULATION PERIOD

All library materials are checked out for two weeks except

1) Framed art prints - 6 week period

2) Films - due by 1 p.m. the day following pickup

BOOK RENEWALS

A book may be renewed for an additional two weeks, provided no one else is waiting for it. Phone renewals are not permitted.

OVERDUES

If borrowed material has not been returned to the library within six weeks after it was due, you will receive a reminder notice. Call the library (452-8541) if you have any questions regarding overdue material.

FINES

There are no fines on overdue material.

LOST BOOKS AND OTHER MATERIAL

If you've lost a book or other library material, you must pay for it at regular retail price. If you do not, your library card will not be renewed.

DAMAGES

If you damage a book or other library material, you will be charged either a damage fee, a binding charge, or the full cost of the book. The charge depends on the degree of damage.
