✓ 1867 Ahtanum mission rebuilt

✓ 1866^{Sept.} Yakima Co. established

✓ 1868 Father, Ft. Onge started school at Ahtanum mission

✓ 1840-1850 1847 - Ahtanum mission established by Oblate Fathers E.C. Chirouse and Parchal Richard

✓ 1847 Whitman massacre and Cayuse war

1870-75 + 1871-1872 - Forerunner of Old Union ditch built by

✓ 1871 - Martin Vaughn came to Fruitvale

✓ 1872-73 probably Vaughn planted

✓ 1871 - Church at Ahtanum mission was dedicated

1850-60 ✓ 1855 Indian treaty ^{June 9} May 30

✓ 1856-57 Ft. Simcoe road built

✓ 1855, Nov. Ahtanum mission burned

✓ 1853 - Washington becomes a territory.

✓ 1855 Agent A.J. Bolon murder

✓ 1853 Lieut Geo. B. McCallan on an expedition to Yak valley

1876-80 - 1879 - Old Union Ditch Co. began operations

1878-79 Indian uprising

1860-65 1865 - Alfred Hanson settled in Wenas

✓ 1865 Augustus C. Cleman brought sheep to valley

1880-85 - 1884 R.R. reached Union Gap

✓ 1885 - R.R. extended to Yakima

✓ 1882 Capt. H. Thomas came to Union Gap.

✓ 1880 - First newspaper started in old town
