The interest aroused by the exhibition of Abel G. Warshawsky's paintings, held at the Maryhill Museum in 1952, has led to this second and more comprehensive showing. Phases of his development not revealed by the first group are illustrated in this one. Landscapes of genuine beauty and distinction, still-lives and a number of his vital portraits afford a new opportunity to observe the artist's versatile talents.

Warshawsky is equally well-known in many parts of America and in many countries of Europe. In France, where he continued his studies begun in this country, and where he made his home for a number of years, he was early recognized as one of the fine painters of his time. The French made him a Knight of the Legion of Honor and added his pictures to the collections of the Luxembourg and other important museums. Upon his return to this country, his pictures were welcomed at exhibitions and his reputation became widespread. Honors of various kinds, medals and prizes have come to him and his exceptional talent for portraiture has been sought by business and industrial leaders everywhere. He is represented in leading museums from New York to San Francisco.

A brilliant, joyous painter, "Buck" Warshawsky has dedicated his life to his ideals of art and subordinated everything else to it. Born with a love for beauty, he uses thoughtful composition, good drawing, lively color, and sound and beautiful workmanship to produce it worthily for others.
