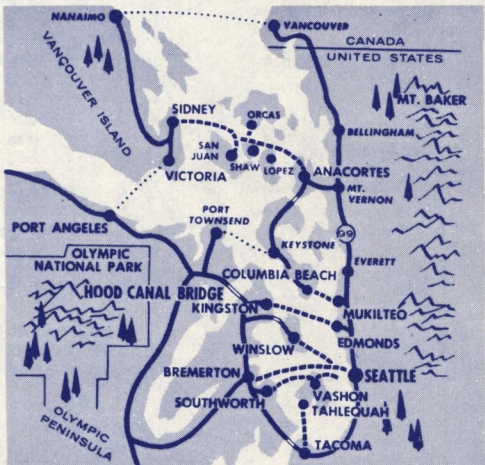

Cruise by ferry into the beautiful San Juan Islands. You may park your car at Anacortes and make this restful, delightful one-day trip as a foot passenger at low cost.

Take a short water trip on the Sound. Ferries leave Seattle Ferry Terminal (Pier 52), Seattle, approximately every half hour. An interesting trip can be made in a couple of hours; cost is nominal. Ask for descriptive folder or call MAIn 4-4755 Seattle for further information.
