The rules are substantially the same as in 1953. Once again, and until further notice, we will be able to give only certificates to the winners. Financial conditions being what they are, the Club is not able to continue the traditional practice of awarding bonds to the winning newspapermen or newspaperwomen.

We are again cooperating with the University of Washington School of Journalism in fixing the date for the annual Awards banquet. The date will coincide with the annual Seminar date.
