



In 1886 Charles M. Russell was an unknown Range Rider in the employ of Stadler and Kaufman, large cattlemen. He made his first appearance by painting the picture, "The Last of the Five Thousand or Waiting for a Chinook," which characterized him as the "Cowboy Artist" and subsequently the most famous artist of his type in the world.

The picture, "The Last of the Five Thousand," depicts an interesting story. During the winter of 1886 there occurred one of the most severe snow storms in the history of Montana. Cattle and sheep died by the thousands. Becoming alarmed, Russell's employers wrote him as to the condition of their stock in his charge. He did not write but with his brush he drew this picture which told its own story. The coyotes awaited the last victim of the storm. This picture became famous as it is the most noted of all of Russell's works.

Charles Russell died at his home at Great Falls, Montana, October 24, 1926, at the age of 61.
