MARKETING NORTHWESTERN APPLES
A Summary of the 1932 - 1933 Season

Marketing of the 1932 Northwestern apple crop was accomplished during a period of economic uncertainty and transition necessitating economic pioneering to an extent which has never before confronted this industry.

Although each fruit-marketing season is unique in itself, the industry has, in past years, been equipped with certain basic knowledge relative to production, supply and demand, which has permitted fairly accurate expectations as to consumer-requirements during the season; and which have led to quite definite trade practices and marketing procedure during the progress of each market movement. These basic factors existed during the past season; but their significance was so minimized by new economic factors, that the entire industry was forced into new and untried methods of operations.

Prices ruled low during the season, descending to unheard-of levels at various times, and with resultant staggering losses to nearly everyone connected with the Industry. The outstanding development of the entire season was probably the demonstration of marketing skill, energy, and resourcefulness which moved the entire commercial output into world-wide distribution. Recognition of the critical financial situation of this entire specialized industry led to the formation of the active partnership between growers, distributors, and the Federal Government, toward the end of the season, for purposes of financing production and distribution of the 1933 crop.

The intent of this Summary is not to analyze nor interpret the economics of the 1932-33 marketing season. Such analysis would involve a profound discussion of domestic and foreign developments, trade agreements, freight rate adjustments, quotas, embargoes, and other international trade barriers, domestic and international monetary standardization, purchasing power at home and abroad, and a score of other vital problems which have become of National and World concern.

The following pages of statistical information pertaining to marketing the Northwestern apple crop are presented in respectful recognition of the magnitude and complexity of the problems now confronting the Industry; and are submitted for possible guidance in the re-establishment of a solvent fruit industry in the Pacific Northwest.
