We, at the newspaper are undergoing the ordeal of conversion to offset printing, after months of preparation. It has been a hectic 10 days for the printers, following changeover of our big press, 1/2 of it now, 1/2 by September. When finished, we'll be large t newspaper in U.S. in offset. I can understand why. It 's a bear-cat for the printers, not much different for us on the news side. But what beautiful pictorial reproductions etc., and in such detail, unbelievable. Conversion is costing the paper \$900,000 in equipment and by the time it 's complete in extra time for printers, pressmen, additional equipment, who knows. Result our news production is and will be curtailed I'm afraid for a while.
