- 3 That the Secretary of the Interior is authorized to contract,
- 4 by negotiation, with any State, county, or public school dis-
- 5 trict for the construction and equipment of public school
- 6 facilities that will provide classroom space for Indian chil-
- 7 dren who are brought by the Secretary from outside the
- 8 boundaries of the public school district, and to extend or
- 9 advance under such contract money appropriated for the
- 10 purpose.
