Sir:

On the 14th inst Jim Macoma took her head of horses and ran away with Mrs McKay and my Police informs me that he has gone to your Agency. My Police knew nothing about his leaving until late tonight so it was too late for them to try and catch him.

Jim was arrested here last week for bringing whiskey on the reservation and giving it to the Indians making eight besides himself drunk.

He has a wife and three children living here he has become tired of his old wife and has taken a fancy to the woman who ran away with him.

You will find Jim to be a smooth

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sacker and will promise to do any
thing that you may desire but
you cant put any confidence in
what he tells you

If they have come to your reserva-
tion please have them both arrested
and put them in Jail and hold
them until I can send for them
as I am determined to have
them.

Jim is a bad fellow to have around
as he can get whiskey from
almost any one and will buy
it as long as he can get
money to buy it with.

Let me know whether they have
been to your Agency or not and
if they are there now have them
arrested and I will send my
