Dr. Kirk Nelson, Glacier Galleries Kalispell, Montana: Dr. Kirk Nelson, owner of Glacier Galleries, Kalispell, Montana, visited Mabton to see the museum, and on learning it was in Yakima decided to visit us. Dr. Nelson had hopes of trading with Dr. Gannon for his Yakima Indian artifacts for those that pertain to his Montana area.

We list the following quotes from his comments:

"Billings, Don Foot, has period carriages and artifacts collection on sale for \$1,000,000.00."

"Montana Historical Society in Helena makes \$100,000.00 net per year on sales in the gift shop."
