## BUDGET REQUEST TO THE LEGISLATURE FOR THE 1965 - 1967 BIENNIUM

The Society assists in the organization and development of local historical societies in 34 Washington communities. The Library of the Society is used by researchers from every state and many foreign countries. Much of the original source material in Society collections is being published and widely distributed. The Society has received national recognition on six occasions from the American Association for State and Local History. The Society was charged with statewide commemoration of the Civil War Centennial, Boundary Survey Centennial, Lincoln Centennial and many more. Attendance has increased steadily each year, both school groups and general visitors.

Increased demands are being made upon the Society. Visiting school groups, researchers, teachers and tourist visitors have increased; for example, we expect to have 1,630 school and community groups in 1965. General attendance is expected to reach 96,000 visitors, in addition, in the same period.
