Dear Colleague:

The call for papers for the Northwest Anthropological Conference, 17-18 April 1964, has been made by the Program Chairman, Carling Malouf, Montana State University, Missoula, Montana, (in case you didn't receive word). This letter has to do with providing shelter and provender for those who will read and listen to said papers.

Pullman does not provide a wealth of choices in accommodations and the attached lists pretty much exhaust the possibilities. However, no conference in the past has stalled for lack of facilities and everyone will be housed even if private dwellings must be utilized. Moscow, Idaho (the home of the University of Idaho) is a brief 8 miles away and provides more housing in the form of hotels and motels, and some of these are listed on an attached sheet.

We are asking that you correspond directly with the accommodating facility concerned if you wish reservations in advance. The earlier the better, especially with regard to the Wilson Compton Union (CUB or Student Union) since the latter has set aside rooms for us but cannot hold them indefinitely. Please note that extra cots are available in many instances. If you have much Mana and wish to flirt with the gods you may want to wait until you arrive to find rooms, but we do not advise such a course in view of the brevity of the meetings and the scattered nature of accommodations.

We are also asking that you indicate whether you wish to attend the banquet on Friday night, 17 April. Drinks will be on an individual basis at 50 cents per highball, and the dinner will cost \$2.25. We would like to know by April 1st how many people plan to attend the banquet.
