Foot. I think it will tell more than I could write.

He seems good, his face is full, so are his arms and legs, but
the doctor told me, before completing tests, that veins closed pretty
quick. I was successful in getting him transferred over to medical
aid, and will keep you posted, of course.

Jack Campbell gave me a call on his return from P.R. said it was ok
to tell you it was ok with him if you cared to have "ditto" struck off
of his preliminary report on the site which the Indians knew as
Shapanchise (they describe it as a rouge) said it was named for some
mineral springs where they got paint on that side of the river.
Such a report would be good to have in my files, for a more complete
and technical ethnography sometime in the future.
