In later years, more Yakima and Palouse ~~were listed~~ or combinations were listed, Yakima meaning of course Yakima jurisdiction. ~~But,~~ why then list Klickitats, which were one of the 14 signers of the Yakima treaty, and why list Palouse, which were not a signer? I still suspect that a look at older records would be revealing as to bloods blood-lines, tribes.

 for those living on the river, ~~in the southern part of the state,~~
^{also} ~~and which was~~ used as Moses Columbia or Columbia, ^{on the Colville} referring to the
