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So Easy To Reach Victoria

BY PLANE

Via TCA. Two flights daily from Seattle. Six flights daily from Vancouver. Convenient limousine service from airport right to Festival Headquarters.

BY BOAT

Tsawwassen-Swartz Bay Ferry (Every two hours on the odd hours 7 a.m. to 9 p.m.)

American visitors may drive from Seattle through Bellingham and cross the Canadian Border at Blaine and proceed to the Tsawwassen Ferry Terminal. The Swartz Bay Terminal is located 17 miles from Victoria.

From Port Angeles, via Black Ball Transportation Inc. Two round trips daily.

Anacortes-Sidney, via Washington State Ferries, One round trip daily.

Vancouver-Nanaimo, via CPR Steamships. Two round trips daily.

Horseshoe Bay to Departure Bay via B. C. Govt. Ferries. Every two hours on the even hour.

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
