1. S. S. KOOTENAY - Wood sternwheeler - 1897-1920. Built at Nakusp. Arrow Lakes Laid up.
2. S. S. LYTTON - Wood sternwheeler - 1890-1902. Built at Revelstoke. Arrow Lakes. Dismantled.
3. S. S. ROSSLAND - Wood sternwheeler - 1897-1916. Built at Nakusp. Arrow Lakes. Foundered.
4. S. S. MOYIE - Wood and steel sternwheeler - Assembled at Nelson Kootenay Lake, 1898. The last of the sternwheelers in operation.
5. S. S. INTERNATIONAL - Wood sternwheeler - 1896-1909. Built at Rash B. C. Kootenay Lake.
S. S. ARGENTA - Wood sternwheeler - 1900-1909. Built at Kaslp, Kootenay Lake.
6. S. S. KUSKANOOK - Wood sternwheeler - 1906-1931. Built at Nelson. Kootenay Lake. Laid up.
7. S. S. NELSON - Wood sternwheeler - 1891-1913. Built at Nelson, Kootenay Lake. Laid up.
8. S. S. NASOOKIN I - Steel sternwheeler. 1913-1932. Built at Nelson B. C. by C.P.R. Kootenay Lake. Sold to Canadian Govt. 1932.
S. S. Nasookin held fast in ice at Nelson B. C.
9. S. S. MARION - Wood sternwheeler - 1888. Built at Golden for F. P. Armstrong. Foundered in mud at Howser Lake-Lardeau B. C.
10. S. S. SPOKANE - Wood sternwheeler - 1892-1895. Built at Bonners Ferry, Ida. Kootenay Lake. Destroyed by fire.
11. S. S. MINTO - Wood and steel sternwheeler - 1898-1954. Assembled at Nakusp. Arrow Lakes. Laid up at Nakusp.
12. S. S. ALBERTA alias STATE OF IDAHO - Wood sternwheeler - 1893 - Built at Bonners Ferry Idaho as State of Idaho. Wrecked off Ainsworth, Kootenay Lake 1893. Sold and refitted 1895. Renamed ALBERTA. Tug HERCULES.
