Enclosed are scanning abstract, typescripts and commentaries covering Oregon Superintendency of Indian Affairs, 1848-73 Roll 11, Microcopy 2

Two of the commentaries are marked "Important." One concerns a reference to the Indians at Priest Rapids. The other to a destroyed Indian village.

This roll was especially prolific in historical material of pre-treaty activities, policy, so it was copied at greater extent than previous rolls. It contains many references and letters that undoubtedly have bearing on other claims filed by various Indian tribes against the Government of the United States, such as the Chinooks, a description of their claims to land, land also claimed by remnant tribes, now extinct, in territory claimed by the Chinooks, etc.
