#### • HELENA'S CIVIC CENTER •

Only a bonanza gold camp would have the audacity to center civic activities and city offices in such Moorish splendor. Originally, the Algeria Shrine Temple.

#### • HOTEL PLACER •

Here on the site of an old placer working, enough gold was dug in basement excavation in 1911 to pay for part of the building.

#### • PIONEER CABIN •

In the 2nd spring of roaring Last Chance Gulch, a young bride planted locust tree sprouts she had carried across the plains, here.

#### • OLD BELL TOWER •

Used in the early days to warn residents of fire. Can be seen from Broadway.



#### • ST. HELENA CATHEDRAL •

Tommy Cruise's gold from the fabulous Drumlunnon mine at Marysville, helped build this Catholic edifice. Modeled after Cologne Cathedral, its 216 ft. twin spires are a favorite landmark.

"The Cowboy Artist"

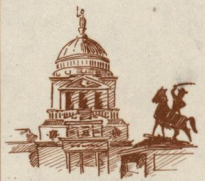

#### • STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY •

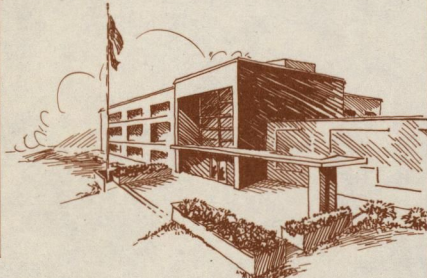
This new \$200,000 structure houses the heart of Montana's history and art. It is one of the finest frontier research centers in the Pacific Northwest (Historical Library); with two fine museums, C.M. Russell Room, both contemporary and Western Galleries of Art, Pioneer and Veterans State offices, all available for free public visits.
