10. What is said in Mark 8:38, and in Matt. 10:32, 33?

11. When I kneel down and pray for pardon, for the sake of what do I hope to be heard?

12. Is what I have done, am now doing, and mean to do, together with my great distress for sin, the *ground* of my expectation?

13. Or are the sufferings and death of Christ the ONLY thing for the sake of which I hope to be heard and saved?

14. How can I be forgiven? See Acts 10:43.

15. How may I become a child of God? See Gal. 3:26.

- 16. And since it is for *Christ's* sake rather than my sake that I am to be saved, can any unfitness hinder my salvation?
 - 17. Is Christ willing now to save sinners?

18. Is he willing to save ME?

19. Can I believe that he is willing to save me NOW JUST AS I AM?

20. Why not? will I ever be more fit?

21. Since I must perish without a Saviour, and since Christ offers to be my Saviour, shall I not at once TAKE HIM as mine?
