The oldest orchard was that of Jacobs. His initials are H.j. or J.h. ?

✓ Weed's orchard is 20 years old, Schwartz's 18 years.

J.P. Marks had apples in early days. 39 years ago Mrs. Marks used to take apple to Yakima and they were about the only ones then offered. The trees were then in bearing and probably were then 20 to 25 years old. - in 1888

✓ Family orchards began to go in in the South Neb Hill district when Hubbard ditch was put in. That was in 1886. That time marked the first subdivisions of land. The ditch was enlarged two years later as there was more demand for water. Its real name is Naches & Cowiche ditch.

Shanne ditch meandered through Yakima.
