Eagle Seelatsee, chairman of the Tribal Council of the Confederated Yakima Indian Nation, Mr. Louis Cloud, secretary, and other members of the Tribal Council have inscribed a copy of Strangers on the Land and asked that it be sent to you.

This is a tribal publication which tells the story of the Confederated Yakima Indian Nation and some of the older history. And although in this economical form of printing, contains 63,000 words, equal to a standard size book.

It was thought you might have a special interest in the Yakimas, which are the tribe, and the only American Indian tribe, upon whose reservation the Disciples of Christ operate a mission.

If you have a repository in mind for one of the few copies of the limited and only edition issued, please designate it and one will be sent. This, however, was inscribed especially for you.
