Dear Mr. Eliscu:

On December 28 I wrote you concerning a United States Postal Money Order in the amount of \$10 that had been sent to the society Sept. 1, 1955 for a patron membership that included the National Sculpture Review.

Since I have received no acknowledgement of that letter, nor have I ever received a renewal of the subscription to the review, I am asking the postal authorities to trace this order.

I am doing this because in the same mail dispatch I mailed a renewal to a magazine and subsequent correspondence with the publisher shows that the order was not received by him. It is possible therefore that both orders were lost in some mail disaster, stolen etc.

If your records show differently your communication to that effect will be immediately turned over to the proper postal authorities in whose hands I have now placed the matter.

The Postal Order Number was 12-27,993,482.
