To the Commissioner of Indian Affairs:

Sir: I have the honor to transmit an estimate of supplies, &c., required for the service at the agency under my charge, as above, amounting to \$ _____, and respectfully ask for the necessary authority to purchase the same ⁽¹⁾

I also ask authority to publish an advertisement, inviting proposals in the case, in the ⁽²⁾

and to make contract with the lowest responsible bidder, or bidders, for the delivery of the articles estimated for.

I have on hand ⁽³⁾ \$ 1600.⁰⁰ available to the proposed purchase, from appropriation

The application to be made of each article, and the necessity for its purchase, must be clearly stated in the remarks. Insert extra leaves when the space is not sufficient.
