Also--if they will---why dont you have them just mail them to me directly, with invoice (including the 3 already received) and then you wont need to bother with it again.

Sorry to learn that you two were not together at Christmas. Hope the New Year was better in that respect, and also that this year will prove to be the BEST of your lives. Please consider the possiblity of visiting with us next time you are over this way, either each alone or together. If we knew ahead of time that you were coming we game could do better still. Anyway, do keep in touch with us. And Click, I hope the Book is going very well.
